## **Sri Lanka – India Trade Ties**

Sri Lanka and India enjoy a vibrant and growing economic and commercial a is also one of the largest contributors to

partnership. India is also one of the largest contributors to FDI in Sri Lanka exceeding US\$ 2.2 billion. In 2022-23, Sri Lanka exported products worth US\$ 1 billion to India while importing products from India worth US\$ 5.1 billion. For the textile and apparel industry, Sri Lanka imported US\$ 146.47 million in yarn, US\$ 311.78 million in knitted fabrics, and US\$ 278.38 million in woven fabrics from India in 2022.

The recent meeting between Hon'ble President Shri Ranil Wickremesinghe and Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi saw the two leaders adopt a 'vision document' to accelerate mutual cooperation across industries and deepen bilateral relations between India and Sri Lanka.


