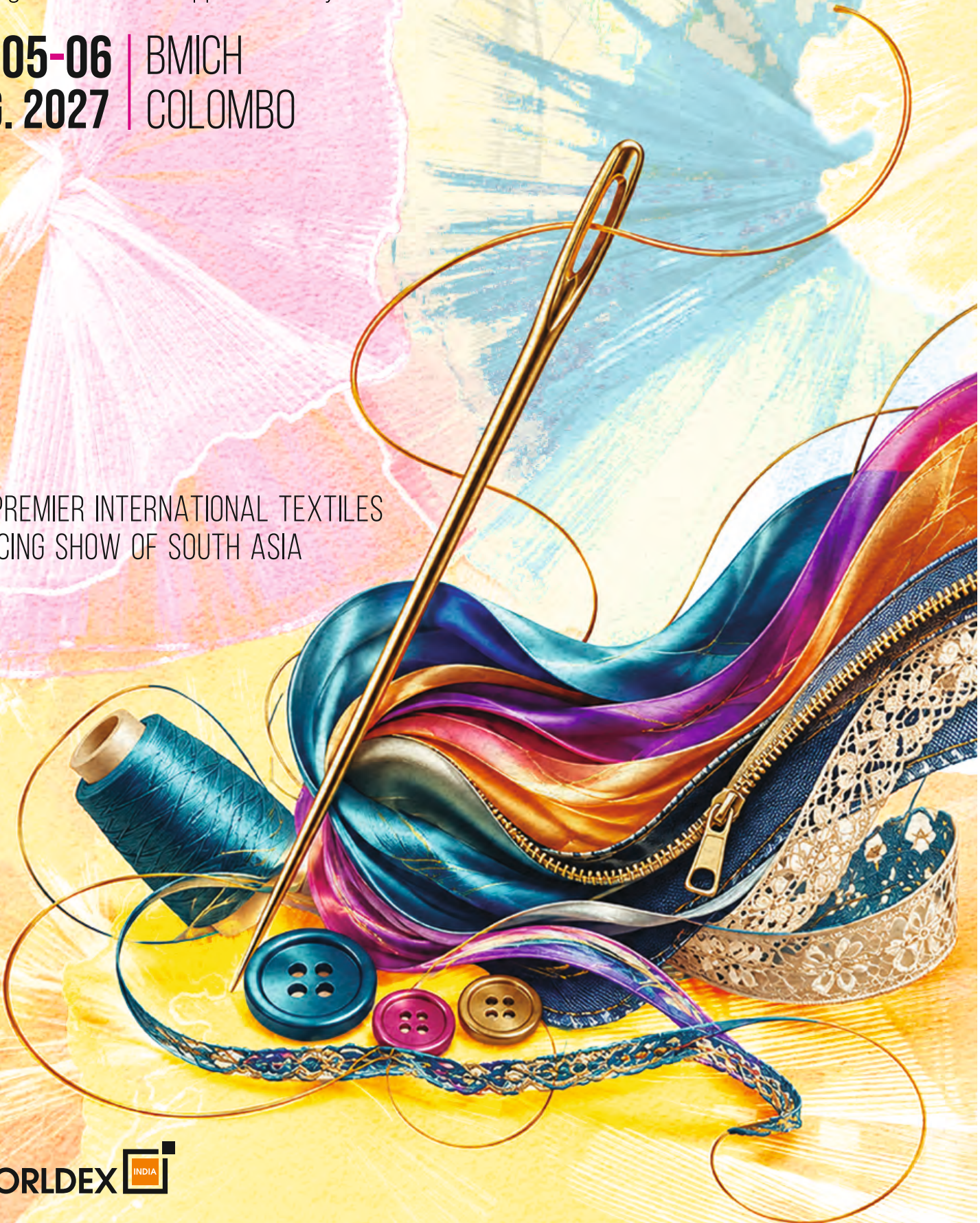

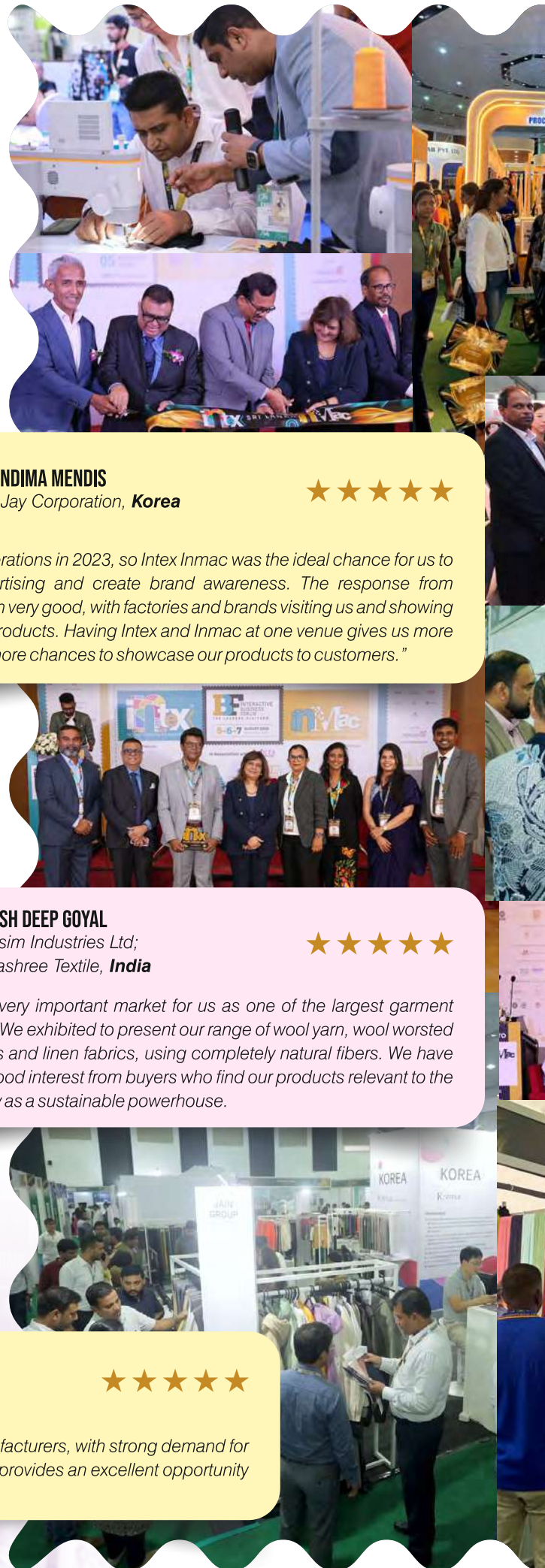

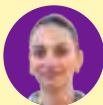

SRI LANKA TEXTILE & APPAREL MARKET 2026

A Premium Apparel Hub
Preparing for its
Next Growth Cycle



Sri Lanka's textile and apparel industry remains the country's largest merchandise export sector, generating approximately US\$ 5.3 billion in export revenue in 2025. The textile, apparel and related products recorded 8% growth in 2025, reinforcing the industry's importance to Sri Lanka's manufacturing economy.

The industry is now entering a new phase. Sri Lanka is targeting US\$8 billion in apparel exports by 2030, creating a clear need for stronger sourcing, greater market diversification and increased manufacturing capabilities.

The domestic apparel market is valued at approximately US\$ 2.3 billion, yet less than 35% of domestic demand is met by local manufacturers. Meanwhile, a revival in domestic consumption is indicated by a 35.2% surge in apparel imports in July 2025.

With the UK DCTS offering zero tariffs, EU GSP+ access and improved US tariff access, Sri Lankan manufacturers are well positioned to pursue new markets, with exports to other markets growing 12.61% in April 2026, particularly as the industry looks towards Africa, the Middle East and ASEAN.

As Sri Lanka works towards US\$8 billion in apparel exports, diversifies markets and strengthens its SME and manufacturing ecosystem, access to innovative materials, global suppliers and advanced textile solutions becomes increasingly important.

Intex Sri Lanka brings international textile suppliers directly into this evolving ecosystem—helping manufacturers discover new materials, expand sourcing options, build partnerships and bridge the gap between changing industry demand and global supply.
